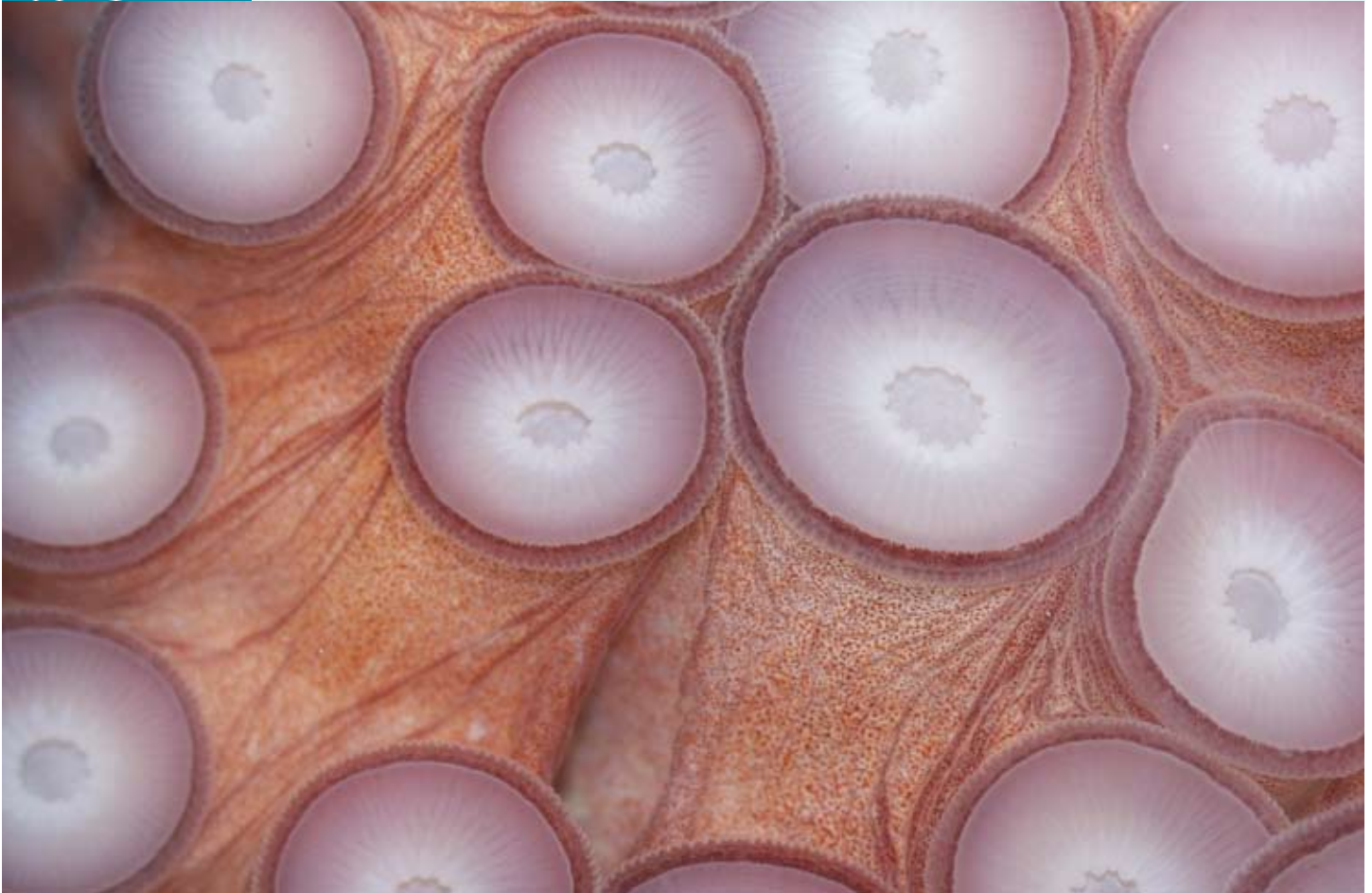


## *Eight Arms, Three Hearts and Blue Blood – Octopuses of the Puget Sound*
