

## Maintaining Your Scholarship Eligibility

You can continue receiving the SSP scholarship each quarter as long as you meet the following eligibility requirement.

- Maintain a quarterly GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Complete a minimum of 12 credits each quarter.
- Participate in 30 cohort hours each year, which is an average of 10 hours a quarter. It is strongly suggested that you participate the 10 cohort hours per quarter, unless you have communicated a plan for which you will participate in all 30 hours in another quarter. For example, if you will be taking the ENGR 290 class in winter quarter, then that would satisfy all 30 cohort hours, and you wouldn't need to complete any cohort hours in the fall.
- Remain eligible for financial aid as determined by the campus Financial Aid Office. This includes filing a new FAFSA each spring.
- Submit a completed *Quarterly Report Form* no later than 4 pm of the first Friday of the new quarter. Make sure to have it signed by your advisor and attach a copy of:
  1. Most recent transcript showing previous quarters grades
  2. Your academic plan
  3. Your class schedule for the quarter that just started
- Last but not least, make satisfactory progress toward your chosen degree each quarter. Basically this means you are following your academic plan and not taking classes that aren't applicable to your academic discipline.
