

Science Scholars Program (SSP)

Probation Policy

In order to maintain their SSP scholarship a student must meet the following requirements*:

- Maintain a quarterly GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Complete a minimum of 12 credits each quarter.
- Complete and turn in a Quarterly Report Form (QRF) before 4 pm on the first Friday of each new quarter, along with the required attachments.
- Make satisfactory progress towards selected degree.
- Make satisfactory progress towards the requirement to participate in 30 cohort hours per academic school year, preferably 10 cohort hours each quarter.

If a student fails to meet any of the requirements in a given quarter, that student will be placed on probation for a period of one quarter. Probation means that the student will continue to receive funding, but at a lower award level, resulting in a deduction in that student's scholarship amount. Students who are currently on the lowest level will not receive any funding during the probationary quarter.

If the student meets all of the requirements during the probation period, that student will be removed from probation and restored to their original award level the following quarter.

Students who fail to meet all the requirement during their probation period will be terminated from the Science Scholars Program, and will not receive further scholarship assistance.

**Scholarship administrators reserve the right to place a student on probation because of an unusual situation not listed above that is deemed worthy of probation.*
